Burns in Different Species





Burnt foot of a Magpie, 3 days after electrocution incident... and one month later – deep partial thickness burn. Loss of scale on leg 2 weeks ago now healing with granulation tissue.



Burnt blue tongue lizard (photo courtesy of Robert Johnson). Deep partial thickness burns around face. Successful release.



Wing membrane of Grey-headed Flying Fox. Central area is black – full thickness burn with eschar. Note the redness around the third finger – partial thickness burn is present. This injury was a consequence of electrocution.
